Rector's Reflection

This week in her funeral we said goodbye to a dear friend of the parish, a member of our family. Many of you may not have known Denise Deacon unless you happen to go to Fun Club, our toddler group that in more normal times meets at St. Nicholas'. In a phone call this morning someone said to me, "I didn't really know her, but she seemed the salt of the earth." The origin of that saying is from Matthew 5: 13 when we are told that we bring the taste of Christ to this world. That was Denise. She brought the flavour of Jesus to all she met and yet she would not have recognised that in herself. In the last years of a life that she did not know would be cut short Denise asked questions of who God is. After an invitation from some of those who befriended her, she sought to know more of Jesus in the confusion of what life can be sometimes. I recently discovered that Denise would go to her son's home to use the internet; and watch our online services as she sought to be responsible for her own journey with Jesus during the pandemic. Seeking God in the mess is the harder route, and Denise took that narrow path to apprenticeship in Jesus. There is a lesson for all of us in those actions as this week we ask what it means to take the narrow path?
