

10. Catch some fish! (John 21:1-24)

Towards the end of John's gospel he tells of Jesus' death and burial and how He comes back to life. We are told in the four gospels that He was seen by His disciples including some women who were with the group. John is the only one to tell this story about Jesus. Read it in your Bible or get someone to read it to you. Some of the disciples went back to fishing after Jesus died. They are trying to catch fish but they get nothing in this story. Then someone on the shore tells them to throw their fishing nets on the other side of the boat. They catch loads of fish! Then they realise that the person is Jesus. He cooks breakfast for them on the beach. It must have been really wonderful and surprising for them to see their friend again and to realise what had happened. Make a collage to remind you about this story.

*Make copies and colour the fish on the next pages. Or draw and colour your own fish. Cut them out and stick them on blue paper or card or paint/felt tip a background for them. Then stick pieces of thread or wool across so that they look as if they're in a net.



Perhaps you could prepare breakfast for your family or help someone to do it. Lay the table and put out everyone's favourite?
