Rector's Reflection

Advent is a lost treasure in some of God's Churches. In our desire to rush to greet the Lord in the manger we can miss the reflection and anticipation found in the journey through Advent. What are our expectations for the future? What difference does the celebration of Jesus' birth make to us? How do we prepare our hearts for the knowledge that God came looking for us in his love? There are many traditions about what each candle means. However traditionally we have observed the first candle as being The Patriarchs. As we reflect on those who came before and pointed to the coming of Jesus, I wonder how we remember with thanks those who pointed us towards God's love, and indeed who do we point towards Jesus? Perhaps now is the time for reflection upon such questions.
