**Easter 5 – Matthew: Beware Tradition** 

#### Collect

Almighty God, who through your only-begotten Son Jesus Christ have overcome death and opened to us the gate of everlasting life: grant that, as by your grace going before us you put into our minds good desires, so by your continual help we may bring them to good effect; through Jesus Christ our risen Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

#### **Rector's Comments**

Last week we looked at what the future might hold and how we journey forward with God as we ACT. Accept that everything changes, however difficult we may find it, but that God Collaborates with us by using us to bring His Kingdom. Finally, we can and must Trust that good will be with us on that journey forward as we ACT. I would encourage you to take a moment to watch that reflection at bedhampton.church/act if you missed it. This week the reflection heads in the other direction looking at what Jesus said about tradition as we return to reading through the Gospel of Matthew. Again if you have missed previous reflections in this series bedhampton.church/matthew is the place to review them. In the same passage where Jesus speaks on tradition, we also see Jesus heal people and are reminded that Jesus is the Chosen Servant. It's a great reminder that the God we trust will be with us to the very end of the age, is worthy of our worship and that trust. It is amazing that the all-powerful creator God has chosen to serve and love us. Even in our doubts and concerns that our traditions are being eroded away, we can know that Jesus is the same today as he was yesterday and will be tomorrow. Now whatever our views on tradition are that is one worth hanging on to.
