Rector's Reflections

"Well I was sitting, waiting, wishing you believed in superstitions then maybe you'd see the signs." The opening words to a Jack Johnson love song. Perhaps unintentionally these are perfect words for where we find ourselves this week. Last Thursday we remembered Jesus' ascension back to the Father and now we sit with the apostles in the still moment before Pentecost next Sunday when He sends his Holy Spirit. I have come to appreciate these reflective moments in our calendar when we get to take stock of what is important.

During this period of praying for God's Kingdom to come in others' lives perhaps we might take a moment to consider our own journey with God. Have we taken the time to sit and wait on God's Spirit to come in our lives? Have we been sitting and waiting for too long and now is the time for us to reach out, cry out and make that move? I can only imagine the fear of the apostles as they waited in that space not knowing that Jesus would be true to his promise and send a helper in the Holy Spirit. Little did they know that when Pentecost did come it would turn their world upside down.

So, this week let us sit, wait and reflect because I can see the signs, He is coming and He wants to turn our world upside down.
