God, who as at this time taught the hearts of your faithful people by sending to them the light of your Holy Spirit: grant us by the same Spirit to have a right judgement in all things and evermore to rejoice in his holy comfort; through the merits of Christ Jesus our Saviour, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

Rector's Reflection

This week we take a brief interlude in our journey through Matthew for Pentecost and then next week for Trinity Sunday. But what is Pentecost? Is it simply the fiftieth day of Easter? It is of course that, but so much more. It is the day Jesus sent His Spirit that we might be included in his plan to see God's Kingdom come to this world, that we might be guided by Him. There are of course scoffers when it comes to the idea that God might guide and nudge us. People who have been hurt or confused by those who would suggest that what they are doing is driven by God's Spirit, perhaps when it is not. But in Acts we see that apostle Paul also suffered these people, as well as those who claimed to know God's Spirit and did not. So let us put aside the image of a white suited TV evangelist who misrepresents God and enables the scoffers. The presence of both in our world is not proof for a God who does not interact with us.

For that is what Jesus sent the Helper for. Do not move on, 'but wait for the gift my Father promised', then move on. That's what he calls those who seek him to do. Are we ready to move on? Then let us receive the gift our Father has promised this Pentecost. Let us see His Kingdom come into our lives and into our neighbourhood. Let us move on from here.
