Rector's Reflections

Our God is a practical god. That is just one of the realities we learn from the study of the historic biographies of Jesus we call the Gospels. Our Father God is not some distant figment of our imagination portrayed as an old man with a bushy white beard sitting on a cloud, but is actively engaged with us today. Jesus speaks of doing what the Father does as he walked about our world two thousand years ago. What does he do? He heals people of their everyday problems, he speaks forgiveness into the lives of the adulterer, he weeps with those who mourn and so much more. This weekend Matthew reminds us that our God is so in touch with the very practical needs that we have, that he provided a picnic for thousands of people because their stomachs were rumbling. What practical needs do you have right now? Your Father God awaits for you to turn to him in the everyday, not just in times of despair, but every day. Perhaps that day is today.
