Rector's Reflections

I love the approach Peter, the disciple, has to life. There is a persistence about his go get it attack on all he does that I admire. He was the one who, when he watched Jesus walk on water, thought I can give that a go. For a while he did walk on water, until he got distracted and sank beneath the waves, only to be rescued by his Lord. Peter was also the one who said he would rather die than leave Jesus, only to deny him three times before that famous cockerel crowed. Nevertheless it was Peter and the meaning of Peter's name being rock that Jesus chose as the example of how His Church should be built. Sometimes Peter's approach might seem like blind faith and optimism in the face of the evidence and his failures. However he did seem to please Jesus, so perhaps we need a little more blind faith in our lives and our churches today.
