Rector's Reflections

As I sit on a bright sunny Monday morning, jotting down my reflections, it actually might feel like today really is "Freedom Day". It is of course not for many who fear what the future holds as we walk into more of the unknown of this pandemic. Just what is our response to this renewed freedom, as our Government turns from enforcement of law to personal responsibility? In another context and another time St Paul said "I have the right to do anything', you say – but not everything is beneficial. 'I have the right to do anything'— but not everything is constructive. No one should seek their own good, but the good of others." For us it may be that the "good of others" means wearing a mask when we don't want to, or not wearing a mask. It may be that the "good of others" is a gentle wave two metres away, or a welcomed hug. With personal responsibility comes the possibility of getting it wrong, but when we all look to the "good of others" that will be the real Freedom day.
