"Have mercy on me, my God", is the cry of the author of our poetic psalm for this weekend. Initially it may bring to mind the picture of a stern king with a grovelling subject at his feet. However, in this case we are not turning to a power hungry monarch who will balance our right to mercy and the impact on his wealth to decide if we shall receive forgiveness. No, in this case we and the poet turn to our Father God who has known who we are for all time. All our mess, all our mistakes and even the fact that we often don't turn to Him for forgiveness because we cannot believe he would want to give that mercy to us. However, He does, and He does it proactively by sending His Son that we may be free to receive that forgiveness whatever we feel we might have done, not because of us, but because of Jesus. Now that is love.
