#### Rector's Reflection

During the second week of Advent we remember the Prophets and, in more recent years, peace. Speaking as a prophet and peace may not seem to be comfortable bedfellows. However God turns our ideas of peace and truth on their heads. Perhaps peace is about motive and manner. When we disagree with one another, is our motive to see God's Kingdom come? Do we want peace to flow in places we inhabit and hearts of those we seek to 'speak truth to'? Does the manner in which we express our knowledge make it more or less likely that those who do not yet profess a love of Jesus, welcome the Christ Child? There is no hidden message here today, just something I was nudged to reflect upon by Holy Spirit. I invite you to join me in that reflection.
