This week we return to our journey through The Gospel of Matthew. We head straight into the human condition with the disciples asking Jesus who will be the greatest amongst them. We often assume that Jesus' response means we should be more childlike, but we will discover this weekend that this may be a cultural misunderstanding. However, approaching Jesus with childlike enthusiasm is a good thing and perhaps, even though it may be a misreading of our passage, we might still learn something from that idea. That is one of the reasons we have a Messy Church service at 10.30am on the first Sunday of the month at St Nicholas' - a place for all to approach Jesus with fun and laughter and discover the love he has for all of us. But what did Jesus really mean? Well we shall find that out this weekend, online or at St Thomas' at 9am. I just love our vision of being a place where all ages gather together to worship God in a range of expressions.
