Rector's Reflection

I am sure you are aware that the root of Mothering Sunday is the ancient tradition of returning to your mother Church, or the Church where you were baptised, on the Sunday in the middle of Lent. A simple gesture of thanks to God for the gifts he has given us. We can see how easily it has transitioned into the simple gesture of giving thanks for those who have taken the role of mothers to us. Jesus cared for his mother when upon the cross with the simple words to his dearest friend John. 'Here is your mother.' As we explore the ancient way of Jesus called simplicity; it might be that those who mother us may not need the grand gesture but would prefer the simple gesture of time and few words. And why not visit your mother Church while you're at it.
