Rector's Reflection

One of my favourite things about our Church here in Bedhampton is the spread of styles and traditions with which we worship King Jesus. Last Sunday we worshipped Him with words, hymns and prayers lifted in the flames of our candles that we lit. Half an hour later He was worshipped in action songs, glue, soil, butterflies and massive foam hands as we lifted more prayer.
