#### Rector's Reflection

We spoke about God's Holy Spirit at our services last week and took some time to wait upon him and be quiet. It was wonderful to hear how God spoke in words and pictures during that time. After the services some shared with me encouragement they received from God, which they felt were for the whole church family. A picture of gold and silver refined in the fire, and from another an image of God's eyes watching us, his people in Bedhampton. These were interpreted as encouragement from our Father calling us to be refined into the people he would have us be, and for us to know he is with us on that journey. It is said that "Fear not" is the most common phrase in the scripture, and it would seem our God would say to us about our journey here that we should fear not.
