Rector's Reflection

Because life can be busy, part of my rule-of-life is to seek to pause three times a day for a brief moment of silence and prayer. It is a moment of drawing myself back to God and putting the worries and businesses of the world on pause for five minutes. I may read a Psalm, simply sit in silence or pray, and I find it brings Father God's peace back into my being. The one I always struggle with, when my reminder goes off on my phone to do it, is the noonday pause. That is perhaps the time I am most caught up in all that is happening around me, and in my mind. However, when I am disciplined and stop for that five minutes it is the most beneficial for my soul and wellbeing. You will find in the news section that in 2025 that I am offering you the chance to join in with my lunchtime Psalms. I encourage you to consider giving yourself the gift of five minutes each day. It may just change your life.
