#### Rector's Reflection

Last week, at our midweek Holy Communion, I shared once again a prayer of Thomas Merton that has always impacted me. This particular prayer begins; "My Lord God, I have no idea where I am going." I wonder if you, like I sometimes can relate to that frame of mind. Most days I jump out of bed eager to see what God will do with the day and how he will manifest himself. But it is also good, to be honest and acknowledge that there are days when we have no clue where God is in our world. Thankfully our moods and emotions, whilst important, do not alter the fact that God is there waiting to engage with us. Merton acknowledges this as he ends his prayer by saying; "I will not fear, for you are ever with me, and you will never leave me to face my perils alone. Amen." Now that's a prayer worth praying on the days we stumble rather than jump out of bed.
