Holy God, you know the disorder of our sinful lives: set straight our crooked hearts, and bend our wills to love your goodness and your glory in Jesus Christ our Lord.

Rector's Reflection

"You, God, are my God, earnestly I seek you; I thirst for you, my whole being longs for you, in a dry and parched land where there is no water."

That is how the Psalmist begins the sixty-third Psalm. A statement of desire to be intimate with the creator God, and perhaps one that many of us could echo. Even those who have no faith might relate to such a desire to be at one with the source of all life. It has been said that there is a missing part of the human psyche, that can only be made complete when at one with God. Perhaps this is why often have a feeling that I am missing out in my devotions to God, that there is more to be had which is just out of sight. Maybe you too feel that itch, but fear not. In the sentiment of my favourite prayer, I believe that your desire for intimacy with God will find closeness, even if there is still more to be had. Let us in the spirit of the Psalmist continue to thirst for that intimacy with our Father God.
