Rector's Reflection

At our Ash Wednesday service this week we reflected upon how we act towards one another as an opportunity to store up treasure in heaven. We wondered how we might use Lent to live out acts of service towards one another. At first glance this might seem a little inward looking when I am always reminding us how we need to be an outward looking Church community. Then I shared how someone once said to me that we will start seeing God's blessing in our parish when we smell good. Yes, I got some quizzical looks, but the explanation is clear, when we consider that it is the aroma of a community in the way they act towards one another that draws others to be part of it. I think we smell pretty good, by which I mean I am often encouraged by the way I see members of our Church family act towards each other. However, I wonder if this Lent we might lift a perfumed smell of worship towards God by doubling down on this and see how that impacts others as they observe our community and see Jesus in us.
