Rector's Reflection

Before the Easter holiday, I shared with a group of school children the importance of Easter to me as a follower of Jesus. They gasped as I explained that Christmas was wonderful and fun, but Easter Day is lifedefining. Without Easter, Jesus is just a wonderful teacher who came and showed us the way that God would have us be. Image bearers of God's love to those around us and into our neighbourhood. However, Easter changed everything. When Jesus died upon The Cross and rose again, he did so many things, the least of which was to beat death for himself.
